Coaching details

6, one-to-one coaching sessions of 90 minutes each tailored to your goals.

Coaching takes place face-to-face, over the telephone or Skype, as convenient. They are offered at intervals to meet individual circumstances. Additional sessions, beyond this initial offer, are available.

Frequently Asked Questions

Do the coaches have experience of my sector?

Are the coaches qualified?

All Career Savvy Women coaches are qualified executive coaches.

Can I have a discussion with one of the coaches before deciding?

As a first step we will talk through any questions you may have about coaching. As part of the call we will discuss what your goals might be.

How will I know if coaching is right for me?

Coaching is a one-to-one partnership between an individual and coach providing a non-judgemental space to achieve the client's goals. Coaching works where clients are willing to make the changes needed to get there. Coaching can be challenging as well as rewarding.

What experience do I need?

This programme is aimed at freelance women working in the radio sector. Creative Skillset expect bursary applicants to have at least 3 paid production credits in radio within the last 3 years or to be returning to radio after a career break. Their bursary eligibility criteria can be found on their website.

What happens if I need more than the 6 sessions on offer?

Clients can have further sessions if they want to continue. The coach will discuss and decide with you what's needed and the additional fee. This would not be covered by the Creative Skillset bursary which is a maximum of £1,500. Also if you don't need 6 sessions the coach will discuss and decide with you how many sessions you may require.

Is the funding from Creative Skillset guaranteed?

After agreeing to go ahead with coaching, clients will need to apply to Creative Skillset for a bursary. They have a limited number of bursaries available.

When will coaching start?

The coach and client will together agree when each of the coaching sessions will take place, to fit with the client's goals.

How long will the coaching programme take?

Coaching is offered through up to 6 coaching sessions. The coaching programme is likely to take place over about 6 months, determined by the client's goals and schedule.
